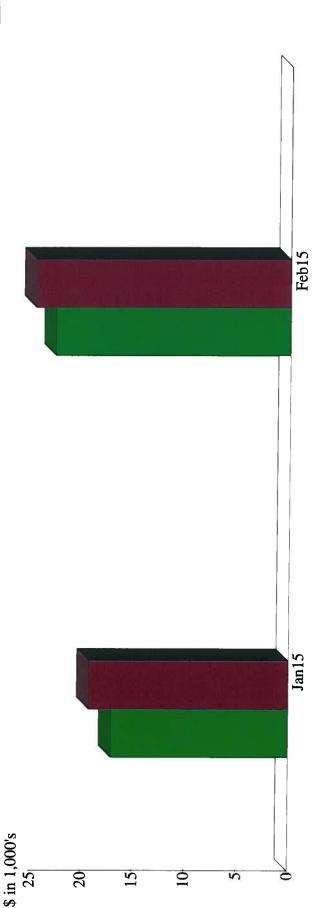

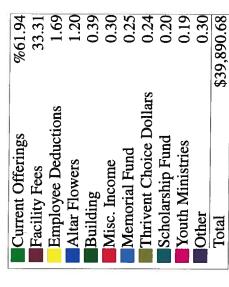

Income and Expense by Month January through February 2015



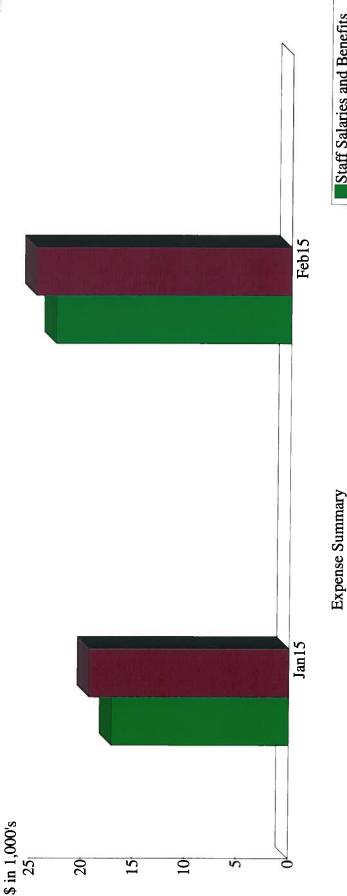


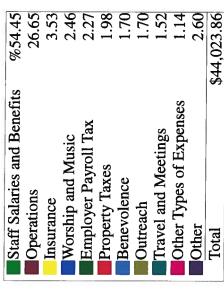


Income Summary January through February 2015

5. Carol McAnern will be handling the orders for Easter lilies. She will also help with the table candles for the Meal in the Upper Room.

OTHER NEW BUSINESS

- 1. The committee asked Paula to discuss with the Council an extensive cleaning day of the church prior to the Easter services. March 28 was suggested as a possibility.
- Marilyn reported that she is working on fixing the eternal candle so that it stands straight in the holder.
